 HALF DOUBLE CROCHET (HDC) HALF TREBLE CROCHET (HTR)

 DOUBLE CROCHET (DC) TREBLE CROCHET (TR)

 TREBLE CROCHET (TR) DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET (DTR)

 DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET (DTC) TREBLE TREBLE CROCHET (TRTR)

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EACH OF THE STITCHES ON THE PREVIOUS PAGE FORMS A BASE FOR MOST CROCHET PROJECTS.
